First the Ambulance attorney wants to see the tax rates in the contract. Robbins stated that you don't want a private business dictating the rates. Black stated that when you levy for taxes you don't ask for a rate, you ask for a dollar amount. The second issue is 3rd party billing. Should the County tell a private business how to do their billing? Beard and Black agreed that 3rd party billing is not needed. Vipond will take this to the Commission, no rates, no 3rd party billing, 1 year contract and put the original wording back in which states the dollar amount of the contract or that amount collected for taxes.
